How Is Jesus Lord?

Some feel that we should not use the term "Lord" when referring to Jesus Christ or God, the Father. Throughout history, there have been many men and mythological "gods" who were referred to as "lord". Should we be afraid of using this term because others (who knew not the God of all creation) misused it?

WHO WILL YOU BELIEVE?

People are free to believe and practice anything they choose, but if they want to know what God thinks on each subject, they should always investigate His inspired written word – the Bible.

"Lord" is used many, many times in the New Testament (see listing on pages 3 and 4). In Matthew 25:21, Jesus speaks a parable portraying His return to Earth and He says: "... enter thou into the joy of thy Lord."

This word for "lord" is the Greek word "kurios" (#2962). It means "supremacy" or "supreme in authority". The old King James Bible renders this word as "God, Lord, master, sir." So, if Christ uses this term (Lord) to refer to Himself; plus Peter, James, John, Jude, Luke and Paul use it often in the scriptures, it would appear to be a profitable term to use. In fact, a short study of some of the scriptures listed at the end of this article will show that the Apostles are urging people to begin referring to Jesus Christ as "Lord".

Note Acts 2:36 where it says "... made that same Jesus ... both Lord and Christ." So Jesus has been made to be "Lord". This obviously is an important teaching in the New Testament. Notice in Acts 10:36 it tells us that Jesus "is Lord of all". Also, note in Philippians 2:11 "...that every tongue should confess that Jesus is Lord,..." Take a few moments to read all the brief excerpts on pages 3 and 4 and it should become very clear that a dominate message of the New Testament is that we are to come to know (and refer to) Christ as "Lord". To fully connect to the gospel of Christ, we have to acknowledge and treat Christ as "supreme in authority" or "Lord" of our lives.

A MAJOR PROBLEM

In Luke 6:46, Christ asks a profound question. He says, "...Why call ye me, Lord, Lord and do not the things which I say?" In essence, Christ is saying "Don't bother to call me Lord unless you are prepared to obey my teachings". Many call Him Lord and neglect to obey Him. Others want to obey Him, but listen to teachings of men, who preach against treating Him as "Lord" (supreme in authority).

Christ understands the major problem people have with the use of the term "Lord." They want the benefits offered by the Saviour of the world, but do not want much "obeying" or "suffering for Christ's sake." Also, many have allowed themselves to be deceived by "religious experts" who explain that their "traditions" are from the Bible. He clearly expresses the problem in the following verse: "This people draweth nigh unto Me with their mouth, and honoureth Me with their lips; but their heart is far from Me." (Matthew 15:8)

Many people that call Jesus Christ "Lord" do not feel that strict obedience to His words is necessary to be pleasing in God's sight, hence "their heart is far from Me." "Know ye not, that to whom ye yield yourselves servants to obey, his servants ye are to whom ye obey; whether of sin unto death, or of obedience unto righteousness?" (Romans 6:16) This verse shows that obedience is a critical factor in determining our destiny.

In most societies of centuries gone by, people understood that "the Lord" was someone to be obeyed. Disobedience to your lord was cause for the death penalty in many cases.

For our lips and our hearts to be close to the Lord Jesus Christ, we need a mindset that says "if you say it Lord, I receive it as a command and I will obey that word." "Jesus answered and said unto him, If a man love Me, he will keep My words: and My Father will love him, and We will come unto him, and make Our abode with him." (John 14:23)

YOU MUST CHOOSE!

When you and I stand before the judgement seat of Christ, we will be judged on our belief of the inspired written word of God and our obedience to it. If we have believed other's views of the Bible contrary to Christ's view, He will probably remind us that He wrote "...Take heed that no man deceive you" (Matthew 24:4) for our benefit, and we failed to obey it. So, the only protection we have against deception is to study God's word for ourselves, praying for God's Holy Spirit to lead us to all truth. For the "simplicity of Christ", just believe and practice what the Bible writers wrote, under inspiration from our "Lord."
