

Jesus told his disciples: "I will come again" (John 15:3). And as he returned to heaven from the Mount of Olives - following his miraculous and spectacular resurrection - God's messengers told the disciples: "Men of Galilee why do you stand gazing into heaven? This Jesus, who was taken up from you into heaven, will come again in the same manner in which you have seen him entering heaven" (Acts 1:11). The prophet Zechariah sketches in

I will gather all the nations to Jerusalem to wage war. The city shall be captured, the houses plundered, the women ravished; half the city shall go into captivity but the rest of the people will not be cut off from the city. Then the LORD will go forth and wage war against those nations as he fights in a day of war. His feet shall stand in that day upon the Mount of Olives which is on the east side of Jerusalem, and the Mount of Olives shall be split in the middle eastward and westward by a very great valley. Half the mountain shall move northwards and half southwards. The LORD will become King over all the earth in that day [the political agenda of Jesus]; the LORD shall be one, and his name one [his religious agenda]

### CLERGY - a Biblical concept?

All major faiths have their 'clergy' mullahs, priests, vicars, bishops, elders etc. In Christianity, it would seem that you can't have religion without them. But are they Biblical?

National events are often decorated by a splendid array of clergy in multicoloured attire - each specific to part of the many-layered hierarchy. Perhaps surprisingly all these religious offices from Pope to Lay Reader - are unknown in the foundation document of Christianity, the New Testament.

The only 'offices' described there are 'overseers and deacons' (Philippians 1:1). The inspired writers considered this as all that was necessary for the functions of the orderly assembly. [Request our article Church clergy - was foreign to the New Governance.]

But such simplicity of structure is alien to most, especially episcopal, denominations. The vast array of church offices has multiplied over the centuries, and much of the dispute within Christianity stems from it.

- Determine to put God, His Word and His work first in your life. Have you made this commitment?
- Realize that true religion is of the spirit and not dependent on the physical - eg religious symbols, pictures, buildings. Are you looking to God for salvation and not to your deeds or religious trappings?
- reflect His revealed Word. If it's contrary to Scripture, if it does not carry God's imprint - discard it. It is 'vain worship', and idolatrous. This applies, for example, to many 'Christian' traditions. It applies also to religious 'holy days'. Only those revealed in Scripture are acceptable to God see Leviticus 23. Have you begun to observe God's Holy Days, and renounced traditional Christian holidays like Christmas, Easter, Saints' Days?
- God seeks positive worship from us each week on His (7th day) Sabbath - not Sunday - coupled with cessation of our normal business activity. Do you now observe God's weekly seventhday Sabbath?
- Our Christian life is marked by recognition of God's pattern of family life. Be on good terms with your family. Have you taken steps (eg forgiveness) to be reconciled to your parents and your children?

### Resurrection...cont'd

He writes: "Just as in Adam all die. so also in Christ all will be made alive again. But each in his own order - Christ first, and afterwards Christ's people at His return. After that comes the end when he is to surrender the kingship to God the Father, when he has abolished all other government and all other authority and power. For he must be King until he has put all enemies under his feet. The last enemy that is to be abolished is death; for God has put all things under his feet.... But when all things have been put under him then the Son himself will also come under Him who has put all things under him, in order that God may be all in all" (I Corinthians 15:22-28).

Did that statement somehow pass you by unnoticed? Paul says that the purpose and summation of history is "...in order that God may be all in all"!

When that time comes all that then exists that was human will be God.

Man was created in the image and likeness of God (Genesis 1:26). Clearly, the physical "mould" that was Adam and his descendants is a mere shell of that image. But its fullness comes when each and

Of course, these principles applied to all God's assemblies. But it is a misinterpretation to assume that the church of God was one tightly-knit organization, 'ruled from the top down', with one man - pope, apostle, evangelist or board - directing every move.

Such an approach to church structure encourages the growth of committees, rules, corporate headquarters, inappropriate business practices, unnecessary bureaucracy. It imposes a rigid doctrinal formula - which, accepted, may inflict heresy on an entire denomination. And has often done so. All such absorb the energies of the church and hinder the work of proclaiming the Gospel of God worldwide.
