OBSERVE GOD'S DAYS

The Bible - ie God's - festivals have existed through time, their meaning being progressively revealed to His people by God in His due time.

They cluster around seven annual holy days. Each has significance for the divine plan. For example, most Christians - especially since The Passion of the Christ film! - are aware of 'Passover' in the Spring, associated with the death of Jesus and the 'Last Supper'. Also the Day of Firstfruits also known as Pentecost - in early summer.

There are others - each significant in the outworking of the divine plan. Many of His followers continue to observe all these festivals, as Godappointed

The power of their symbolism overshadows the 'weak and beggarly' humanly-devised festivals of modern Christianity, festivals derived from the ravings of ancient false prophets.

ETERNITY the closing of man's day

The symbolism of the eighth day of the autumn festival focuses on *eternity* - God's 'end game'.

The number 'eight' - mentioned eighty times in Scripture - is associated with new beginnings, a new order. Examples are the 'eighth day' - the first day of a new week. Jesus, following his resurrection at the beginning of the eighth day, Sunday, presented himself before the Father on that day in his new spirit body. Eight persons survived the Great Flood to enter the new world. God's people were covenanted through circumcision on the eighth day of life. Even in physics - for the eighth note on a musical scale is the same as the first note. etc.

Within Judaism, this eighth day following the seven days of Tabernacles - is 'a festival in itself'. It is a time of exuberant jubilation - a veritable marriage feast. "...it is this day which above all expresses the joy of the Jewish religion" (*Teach Yourself Judaism* p.188).

This eighth day is called 'a day of restraint' (Nehemiah 8:18, KJV margin), but known as the 'closing day' (*see LXX*). It represents the culmination of God's plan for man. We begin, formed from earth's elements in the image and likeness of God (Genesis 1:26). as 'clay models' of what God wants us to become.

The Psalmist wrote: "What is man that you are mindful of him, or the son of man that you take care of him. You made him a little lower than the angels. You have crowned him with glory and honour and set him over the work of your hands. You have put all things in subjection under his feet (Psalm 8:4-6).

For it was fitting for him for whom are all things and by whom are all things, in bringing many sons to glory, to make the captain of their salvation perfect through sufferings" (Hebrews 2:6-10). Paul adds: "The Spirit bears witness with our spirit that we are the children of God, and if children then heirs - heirs of God and jointheirs with Christ, if indeed we suffer with him that we may also be glorified together (Romans 8:16-17)

We are 'to be brought to glory'! That's God's end-game for mankind. He gives us opportunity - and we must each one of us grasp it personally - to be transformed from dirt to glory. It is summed up by Hannah (I Samuel 2:8) "He raises the poor from the dust and lifts the beggar from the ash heap, to set them among princes and make them inherit the throne of glory".

Interestingly, the context of her prayer was an annual sacrifice - likely, the autumn festival (*ch* 1:7).

Each of the 'holy days' God has revealed is an important guide to the divine plan for mankind - for now and for eternity. Not least is this *closing day* of the festival year, pointing us to the culmination of His magnificent plan.

Forgive - and be Forgiven

"To err is human, to forgive is divine". What does the Bible teach? John Morton

The model prayer that Jesus Christ gave to His disciples tells us to seek forgiveness from God our Father for our debts (Matthew 6:9-13). "Debts" refer to our sins (Luke 11:4). According to Scripture we have all sinned (Romans 3:23) and if we say we haven't then we deceive ourselves (1 John 1:8).

Sin is the transgression of the law (1 John 3:4) and the result of our sin is death (Romans 6:23). Having sinned we are all under the penalty of the law, which is eternal death. What can we do? Do we have to die? Our merciful God wants us to have eternal life, to live and reign with Him forever (Revelation 22:5).

God gave His son that we might be forgiven. He paid the death penalty for us that we might have eternal life (Romans 5:8, John 3:16). If we turn to God and sincerely and genuinely repent of our sins He will forgive us (Acts 3:19, Colossians 1:13,14).

When someone transgresses the law of God they are answerable to God and only He can forgive them. We cannot forgive a person for their sins against God. We can forgive them for transgressions against us personally, but they are still ultimately answerable to God. Only God the lawgiver has the power to forgive (*see* the last part of Mark 2:7 and Luke 5:21). When we confess our sins to God, He will forgive (Psalm 32:5).

Learn To Forgive

In the process of forgiving us He wants us to learn to be forgiving to-

ward others. Notice in the model prayer (Matthew 6:12), Christ said to pray to the Father to forgive our debts (sins) as we forgive our debtors, *ie* as we forgive those who have sinned against us. The lesson of forgiveness is so important for us to comprehend that Jesus elaborates "For if ye forgive men their trespasses, your Heavenly Father will also forgive you. But if ye forgive not men their trespasses, neither will your Father forgive your trespasses." (Matthew 6: 14-15).

Unless we have a forgiving attitude toward others, we will not be forgiven. If we are not forgiven then we are not saved from the penalty of death that we have earned as wages of sin. God wants us to repent of our sins (Acts 3:19). He is willing to forgive and forget, to blot out all record of our sins (see also Psalm 103:3,4,12 and Isaiah 43:25).

others do to us (Ephesians 4:32)? Or do we use every opportunity to re-

mind them of their transgressions? If someone, who has offended us, is sorry and repentant we are to forgive them as commanded (Luke 17:3-4). But will we forgive and forget, or will we continue to feel ill-will toward them?

Who Do We Forgive?

The Scripture we have just looked at talks about forgiving a brother who has repented. Does this mean that we only need to forgive those who repent of what they have done to us? We do well to look toward the example of Jesus Christ, God's own son. Even when people were reviling,

abusing and hitting him, he prayed "*Father, forgive them for they know not what they do*" (Luke 23:34). He did not wait for them to repent.

Notice that in the model prayer we mentioned earlier (Matthew 6:12, 14-15), in giving this instruction Christ did not give any indication about being selective as to who we forgive. He talked about forgiving men, generically implying all people, for the sins they have committed against us, which also implies all sins against us. He even tells us to pray for our enemies (Matthew 5:43-44).

How Often?

The disciple Peter asked Christ if he really meant we must forgive seven times as if that was pushing the limits, and Christ replied that we need to forgive "*until seventy times seven*" (Matthew 18:21-22), showing that we are to continue to have an attitude of forgiveness regardless of the number of times someone offends against us.

God will wipe all our sins from remembrance (Hebrews 10:17), and He expects us to do the same for others. If we bring up past grievances to

> throw in the face of someone who has offended us, it shows we have not really forgiven

them for those past grievances. If we allow our minds to dwell on offences that have been committed against us we become vulnerable to Satan's devices (II Corinthians 2:10-11).

When our attitude is not right we harm not only the relationship with the other person, but our relationship with God as well (Isaiah 59:2). The result is that our attitude deteriorates into one of unforgiving bitterness (Hebrews 12:15). The more bitter and revengeful we become the harder it is to forgive, and if we have not forgiven then we cannot expect to be forgiven. A bitter and unforgiving

THE ROOTS OF SEXUAL DISEASE

Origins of Disease

Disease isn't at source a divine infliction. Misuse your computer and it will as a result malfunction. Meddle with your computer's capabilities and you can generate a destructive 'virus' or 'worm' able to disrupt millions of other users. Such effects happen without Bill Gates programming them! Others have.

Here's the analogy. Personally ignore the Laws of health and you become ill. Manipulate the human or animal or plant - genes and you may, just, precipitate an epidemic. Also, we are all affected adversely by environmental factors - the result of human interference.

Ancient Wisdom

The Bible term for all this meddling with nature is sin. Our first parents (take that as creation or evolution) overthrew the Creator's foundation Law of Life, precipitating a crisis from which we have not recovered. And won't - until all humanity finally comes, in his Millennial Kingdom, under the universal sacrifice of Jesus Christ.

The apostle Paul - writing of the early ages of man - neatly sums it up:

God gave them up in agreement with their inner cravings to such impurity as dishonoured their own bodies.... For this reason God abandoned them to shameful passions. Their women perverted natural functions for the unnatural, and similarly the men forsook their natural relationships with women and burned up with lust for one another. men committing shamelessness with men and so acquiring in their persons the penalty that was coming to them on account of their wrong behaviour Romans 1:24-27

perverse official Government policy, 'reality television', advertising, fashion and the precipitous decline in public moral standards

Inner city streets - and increasingly suburbia and rural areas - are nightly splattered with drink-laden youth, all too often resulting in unwanted pregnancies - and foul destructive sexually transmitted disease. Send them on holiday and their libidos are unleashed in a sexual frenzy.

Divine Cure

None of this is simply twenty-first century. History is littered with nations in decline through immorality. Gibbon, for example, cites the marriage merry-go-round as a reason for Rome's fall. Let's look at another historical and more accurate record - the Christian Bible.

A mass destruction of humanity happened nearly five thousand years ago. One of the factors was a form of sexual sin - that perennial failing of fallen man. 'God saw that human wickedness was growing out of bounds on earth, that the intention of all human thinking produced nothing but evil all day' (Genesis 6:1-8).

Only one family retained its integrity. As for the rest: 'God looked at the earth and saw how degenerated it was; for all those living on the earth had perverted their way' (v.12). All except that one family were wiped out and a new beginning made.

Fast forward a few centuries and we find another family with whom God can work: that of Abram, later called Abraham. Such was his piety that God selected him to be 'a father of many nations' through his son Isaac.

God had a secure homeland the tribe of the iniquitous Amorites. earmarked for Abraham and his progeny: Palestine. It was occupied Palestine Defiled by descendants of Canaan, the Canaan had committed an obscene

attitude can cause us to fall from God's grace.

When we finally come face to face with God, will He be able to forgive us for our sins? Or will we have fallen from grace because we have been too unforgiving toward others? It's not too late to change (Ephesians 5:15-16 and 4:32). But change we must if we want to escape eternal death.

The choice to forgive - or not to forgive - is ours to make. The reward for making the right choice is that we, in turn, will be forgiven.

Amorites (off-spring of Canaan) had developed the same perverse habits. But God is patient, and He allowed them time to repent. But God could foresee the outcome: "...the wickedness of the Amorites is not yet brim full" (Genesis 15:16), He informed Abraham.

The extent of their evil behaviour was described to Israel as they were delivered from Egypt and before they entered Canaan. It included incest, sexual promiscuity, homosexual behaviour, bestiality. "...you shall not behave as they behaved in the land of Egypt where you lived, nor as they do in the land of Canaan where I am taking you" (Leviticus 18:1-5).

These, says God, were sexual practices in Egypt and in Canaan and 'rendered the country unclean'. For this reason '... the land will throw out *you too* [Israel], *when you defile it, as* it disgorged the nation that preceded *vou'* (*vv*.27-30)

Does God Exist? In the beginning God...

He that comes to God must believe that He exists and that He becomes the Rewarder of those who search for Him...Hebrews 11:6

The vast majority of earth's billions believe there's a God of some sort. The confusion of ideas about Him, however, is but an excuse for disbelief. But just an excuse. For the evidence for His existence is before our eyes.

- The Hubble telescope is sensitive enough to peer thirteen billion years into the past. Yet no-one imagines this incredible piece of engineering somehow selfassembled; launched itself into orbit and maintains itself. Clearly, it was designed and crafted by a greater intelligence
- Astronomers believe the latest 'snapshots' from Hubble take us back to a 'mere seven hundred million' years after the assumed 'Big Bang'. Supposedly, that event is the origin of all physical matter
- But wait! That unbelievable powerhouse of stored energy which 'exploded' to

form our Universe is obviously not 'the first cause'. Where did that ball of energy come from? Whatever your view of origins, that question must be answered

- All Earth's material, all the elements, must derive in some form from that original 'big bang'. Take, for example, radium. It is radio-active with a 'half-life' the time taken for half of the atoms of a radioactive substance to decay of just sixteen hundred years. Why has only a portion of it become inert lead? Why not all of it?
- The universe we inhabit is physical. All science requires dependability - that what is experimentally true today will be true tomorrow. We exist and survive by immutable Law. Where did *that* come from?
- Here's a challenge for you. Create for me a grain of wheat, or, perhaps man's supposed simplest ancestor, an amoeba. *No*, you may not use existing genes! Start with *nothing* not even air; and you don't

have any instruments. (And you aren't even there!) Any luck? It's axiomatic that life of any kind derives only from pre-existing life. No-one has yet produced blood from a stone!

- The 'First Cause' the uncreated Creator God - is a dimension incomprehensible to mere physical beings. He is Spirit. Logically, He must have always existed, otherwise we must accept that *matter* has always existed. And that inert matter gendered the human mind. It was *God* who created the complexity of the physical dimension
