We are now stuck with that corruption ('sin'), and can no more expect perfection. Sin distorts our vision. Like Adam and Eve we think our own reasoning surpasses God's wisdom.

The result? Our governments allow child molesters and foul murderers to roam free. Greed dominates business. Our legal system is a tangled web of deceitful practice. We assault our bodies with known killers and pollutants. We pollute our minds with all kinds of perverted filth.

Then we wonder why we are in trouble! We blame God for His non-intervention. Yet we ignore the Manual. The Manual - the Bible - explains how to deal with rapists, kidnappers, murderers, thieves, perverted sex, the young and the elderly, the environment. It enlightens us about marriage and warns against our meddling with it.

AUTUMN FESTIVALS

They are almost upon us! Bible students have long understood the spiritual value of the Biblical festivals. Despised by most Christians as mere 'Old Testament stuff' - and therefore deemed almost 'valueless' - they provide life-giving insight into God's plan for us. More - Jesus Christ is present in type in all of them.

Not only do the festivals hold theoretical lessons for us - they are *meant to be observed* by Christians. Certainly they were observed by the apostles and by the early church, both Jew and Gentile. They are today a vital part of Christian observance. Unlike Christmas, Easter *etc* they have clear Biblical roots and reflect the present will of God for all His people.

The *Day of Trumpets*, for example (September 7 this year - the dates on our calendar vary from year to year) enlightens us about the awesome end-time planet-shaking events preceding the return of Jesus. Much of the mayhem of those days is the culmination of human mismanagement - but in control of events is Jesus Christ, as detailed in the Book of Revelation.

Following Trumpets (September 16) comes the *Day of Atonement*. It's a day of fasting, and represents 'corporate' reconciliation to God - of Israel and of the church - through the atoning sacrifice of Jesus the Messiah. Many believe it is, too, a picture of the 'binding of Satan' by Jesus prior to his thousand year banishment (Revelation 20).

At the end of the year (on the calendar used in Bible times) is the *Festival of Tabernacles* - seven days of celebration, worship and fellowship. Around the world it will this year be observed by the churches September 21 - 27. Tabernacles - 'temporary dwellings' - is a snap-shot of our temporary material life, especially under the direct rule of Messiah. It is immediately followed (September 28) by an eighth day - 'closing day' - representative of eternity.

Days the Lord Has Made

Brethren make every effort to take part in these 'holy convocations' which God has appointed for the festival days. They are a time to worship Him, to fellowship, to hear and study God's Word, to enjoy good food. But central to the celebrations is *The Word*. The festivals - especially the week-long Tabernacles - are not holidays! Nor are they a time for self-indulgent excess and endless entertainment. At heart the festivals are spiritual - a 'meeting with God' on the days He has appointed in the context of joyous loving fellowship and sharing of our resources.

In our taking active part in these God-ordained festivals, Christians more readily understand the divine plan - and draw ever closer to our Saviour, who is central to all of them.
